Observations and Suggestions of the Committee

Observations


- 1) Kovai Kalaimagal College of Arts and Science has 8 UG Programmes, 4 PG Programmes, 1 PG Diploma Programme, 2 M.Phil and 2 PhD Programmes.
- 2) It has adequate infrastructure in terms of Classrooms, Laboratories, Library, Playgrounds, Hostel, Canteen, etc.,
- 3) The College has conducted all the Statutory Body Meetings as per the guidelines of UGC.
- 4) The College has adequate number of Teaching Faculty and implements ICT enabled Teaching Methods, Activity Based Learning, Google Class rooms.
- 5) College has secured **89th Rank** among the top hundred colleges as for as the performance of the courses offered under Science stream in the All India survey conducted by "The India Today" a reputed weekly magazine.
- 6) College has secured **42nd Rank** among the top fifty colleges for the performance of **Bachelor of Computer Applications** programme offered in our college in the All India survey conducted by "The India Today" a reputed weekly magazine.
- 7) The Library is fully automated with sufficient number of Books, Journals and Magazines.
- 8) The College has incorporated Environmental Studies, Value based Subjects, Skill Based Subjects, Non-major electives and Extra Credit Courses in their Curriculum. - 12) 100 % of job aspirants were placed during the year 2018-2019
- 13) Achievements
 - * 71 Students have been brought laurels by winning prizes in various competitions
 - * Mr. T.Hariharan of I B . Com (CA) won first prize in Kata and Second Prize in Kumite at JSKKOI Open National Karate Championship 2018 at Goa, second prize in Kata at South India Level Karate Game 2018 at Dindugal.

- Mr. T. Pradeep of II B . Com (PA) won Second prize in Kumite and Third Prize in fight at JSKKOI Open National Karate Championship 2018 at Goa, third prize in Kata and First prize in Kumite at South India Level Karate Game 2018 at Dindugal.
 - 75 Workshops, Guest Lectures, Seminars, Extension Activities, FDPs and 2 National Conferences were conducted
 - 22 Scholars had completed M.Phil Program and 04 scholars had completed Ph.D. Program.
 - Four of our Faculty members had completed M.Phil and 2 Faculty members were awarded with Ph.D.
 - The faculty members published 25 papers and the students published 02 papers in various reputed National and International Journals.
 - The faculty members presented 35 papers and the students presented 64 papers in various reputed National and International Conferences/Seminars.
- 14) The College has Entrepreneurial Development Cell and Women Empowerment Cell, Citizen Consumer Club, Auditor Club, Red Ribbon Club, Eco Club functioning in full swing.
 - 15) Students are supported with Additional Coaching, Remedial Classes, Guidance and Counselling Cell, Grievance Redressal Cell, SC/ST Scholarships, Merit, Sports and Management Scholarships.
 - 16) Students are involved in Co-curricular and Extra Curricular activities through NSS, Youth Red Cross, Eco Club, Red Ribbon Club, Fine Arts Club etc.
 - 17) Tutor ward System is maintained
 - 18) The Finishing School Training Programme for students gives training for all round development of the student by imparting specific skill sets that required for campus placements.
 - 19) Aptitude classes and Soft Skill development programmes are conducted for final year UG students in connection with Placement Drives.
 - 20) The College has conducted Alumni Meeting on every year.
 - 21) Alumni members have been invited for Guest Lectures and Special Trainers for Finishing School Programme.
 - 22) The College has arranged the TCS Affirmative Action Training Programme for Economically Backward Students.
 - 23) Visitors profile is maintained.


- 24) The College has served the nearby rural community through Extension Activities, Training programmes and awareness programmes.
- 25) The Bridge Courses in Mathematics, Computer Science and Commerce are conducted for Students of 1 year UG.
- 26) The College has signed the MoUs with industries to facilitate internship training and for the conduct of certificate courses.

Suggestions

- 1) Motivate faculty to participate in Orientation/Refresher programmes (at least 1 programme in each semester and orientation/refresher at least once in 5 years)
- 2) The Faculty members should increase the submission of research proposals to various funding agencies.
- 3) Percentage of publication in few departments are less than normal publishing rate (No's per faculty is very less)
- 4) Students may be admitted for PhD in Department of Computer Science and Research
